## Practice Profile

## Past and Recent Instructions

- **NMC v F** – Represented a nurse accused of dishonesty. No case to answer was found in respect of the dishonesty charge and impairment.
- **R v K** – Represented a defendant charged with common assault. The Defendant, who was of good character, was acquitted.
- **R v S** – Prosecuted a defendant charged with dangerous driving on retrial.
- **NMC v B** – Represented a nurse charged with assaults of patients within their care and wider clinical failings. Following cross-examination of 16 witnesses, the panel found no facts proved in respect of the allegations of assault, and no impairment in relation to the minor
