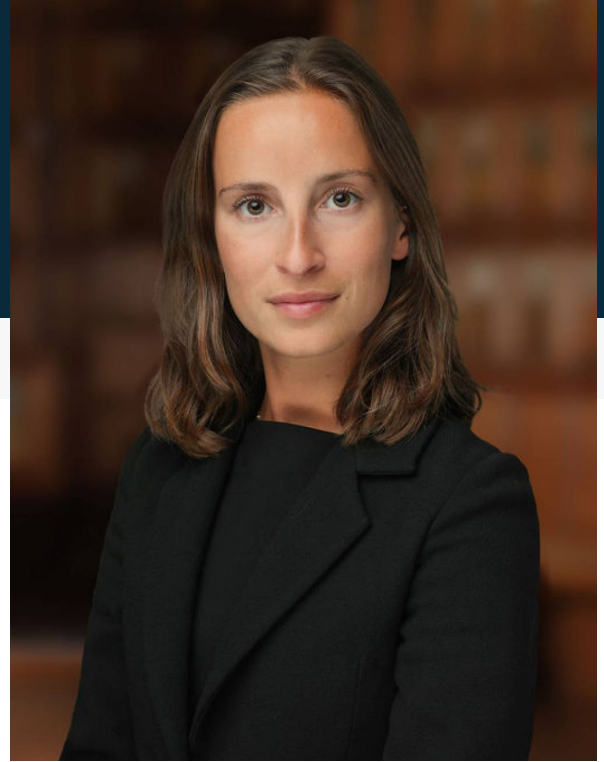
Rosalia has a busy practice specialising predominantly in criminal defence and professional discipline.

Rosalia has acted in a wide range of criminal matters, including human trafficking, violent and drug offences. She has appeared in the Court of Appeal where she successfully secured a reduction in sentence.

In her regulatory practice, Rosalia represents professionals accused of misconduct involving dishonesty, sexual misconduct and fraud, before regulators including the Nursing and Midwifery Council, the Health and Care Professions Council, the British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy and Social Work England.
